The Rural Ambassador Award is conducted by Local shows, Sub Chambers and the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies Inc. in support of our 128 shows across Queensland.

The State Finals are held in August each year during the Royal Queensland Show. Finalists are chosen by qualification through local Shows, progressing to Sub– Chamber and then to State Final. After final judging, the State winner is eligible to compete in the National Finals held at the selected State Royal Show each year. Conditions of entry apply to all three tiers of entry of this award.

Entry Requirements:

Candidates should be:

- Aged between 20 years and 30 years inclusive as at 1 May in the year of the competition.
- Residents of Queensland for at least three (3) months, or if resident near a State border can show they are an active working member of a nominating Queensland Show.

- Be able to spend the required time at the local Show, Sub-Chamber Finals and then attend the State Finals during the period of the Royal Queensland Show.

The Rural Ambassador Award Aims:

- Highlight the importance of young people in rural and regional Queensland, in particular those associated with the Agricultural Show movement.
- Identify young people actively involved in their local shows and community who have a sound knowledge of current rural issues pertaining to their area, Queensland and Australia.
- Have a strong affiliation towards agriculture.
- Seek young people who symbolize the rural spirit—people with vitality who are forward thinking and with a passion for the land and local country Shows.
