FOOD

There is several food and drink outlets situated surrounding the track. A wide variety of hot and cold food is available for purchase, as well as hot and cold drinks.

ALCOHOL

The Kingaroy Speedway is strictly a NO B.Y.O. track. Management and security reserve the right upon entrance to the venue to inspect bags, eskies or containers for the presence of alcohol. Alcohol is available for purchase at the "Bar" which is located next to the Main control tower near the start finish line or up on the back straight "Hill Bar" located on the western side.

RESTROOM FACILITIES

Men's and ladies toilet facilities are available in both the pits and the public areas. The restroom facilities near the Main control tower offer toilets, showers and change rooms.

EVENT CANCELLATION

Should it be deemed necessary, whether due to inclement weather, mechanical or electrical malfunctions or any other unforeseen circumstances beyond the promoter's control, to cancel the event before the SIXTH event, pass-out tickets for the very next race meeting will be issued. No money will be refunded under any circumstance.

PIT AREA RESTRICTION

Unfortunately, we must restrict access to the pits unless you have a "pit pass". We welcome you to look at the cars and talk to the drivers after the race meeting, but we must ask that you refrain from this area during the race meeting. Dress code for the pit area requires that closed shoes must be worn. If you want to gain access to the pits during a race meeting, you can purchase a "Pit Entry Pass" from the Pit gates for only \$10.00. The Pit Area is an alcohol free zone at all times. We welcome you to come down to the pits for free, after the meeting has finished, to get your favourite drivers autograph!!!

Welcome to Kingaroy

Kingaroy is an agricultural town and locality in the South Burnett Region, Queensland, Australia. It is approximately 210 kilometres or about 2½ hours drive north-west of the state capital Brisbane. The town is situated on the junction of the D'Aguilar and the Bunya Highways. Kingaroy has experienced growth in recent years with the population reaching 9,586 at the 2011 census. Rural settlement of the area dates back to 1843, however the Markwell brothers settled the district where the Kingaroy now stands in 1878. Kingaroy celebrated its Centenary in 2004. Kingaroy is the largest town in the South Burnett region.



It is known as the "Peanut Capital of Australia" because Australia's largest peanut processing plant is located in the town and peanut silos dominate the skyline (pictured top right). Kingaroy is also well known as the hometown of former Premier of Queensland, Sir Joh Bjelke-Petersen.

Kingaroy also has a vibrant sporting, cultural and social life and is home to an art gallery and several local craft outlets as well as a range of well-maintained and attractive parklands. The town is home to a number of leading sports people including NRL players Chris Sandow and Chris McQueen Wallabies centre/fly-half Berrick Barnes, as well as former Australian cricket test and one-day opening batter Matthew Hayden and Southern Stars women's cricket Australian representative bowler Holly Ferling. The town has two lookouts (at nearby Mt Wooroolin and Apex Park in Fisher Street) which provide striking panoramic views across the area. Kingaroy also has its own golf club, cricket club, bowls club plus the Kingaroy & District Tennis Association and of the course our notable Speedway track. Along with this Kingaroy has a rich history with Australia's four Football codes with Rugby League being arguably the most popular sport. The Local Kingaroy Rugby league football team is known as "the Red Ants". This popular team name comes from the origin of the name Kingaroy, which is claimed to be derived from the Wakka Wakka Aboriginal word for 'Red Ant'. The red ant features on the old Kingaroy Shire coat of arms.



Kingaroy has the most cosmopolitan feel of any South Burnett township but it's still a relaxed, friendly and informal country town at heart. It has the typical low-humidity climate of all South Burnett townships and is surrounded by extensive (and very picturesque) farmlands interspersed with low rolling hills.

Traditionally, Kingaroy has always been the centre of Australia's peanut and navy bean industries but since the early 1990s it has also developed into one of the twin hubs of the South Burnett's rapidly expanding wine industry (the other hub is at Murgon, Redgate and Moffatdale, 55 kilometres (34 mi) to the north). Several wineries are located either in or very close to the town, along with the Booie Range Distillery which opened in 2001 — only the third distillery in Queensland.

Droughts and uncertainty surrounding the region's annual peanut crop led some farmers to diversify and grow grapes. Rich volcanic soil, hot dry summers and cold winters proved to be ideal conditions for wine growing. Quite a number of vineyards were established in the region, and the success of their wine enables the South Burnett region, which includes Kingaroy, to promote the area as a tourist destination.

Other than grapes, peanuts and navy beans, other crops commonly grown in the Kingaroy area are sorghum, wheat, corn, sunflowers, citrus fruits and duboisia, a kind of plant often used for pharmaceutical products. Hardwood Forestry Plantations have been prominent across the landscape since the early 2000s, having been established on many farms in the region as joint ventures between Landholders and the Queensland Government. The Plantation Forestry Industry is expected to provide employment for many locals in the future. So enjoy your time in Kingaroy and the IBRP / AHI SSA National Modified Sedan Title.


